••SPECIAL LODGING FOR MUSICIANS!

PARKSIDE, this charming art gallery, across Ryus Street from La Veta Park offers sleeping accommodations on the second floor – three bedrooms each with a double or queen size bed, and there is a living room with a pull out double mattress. Room for up to 8 people. Cost for combined Friday and Saturday nights of the festival is \$350, which can be split 6 or 8 ways depending on the size of the group. The facility also provides a small kitchen on the gallery floor. It must be noted that the downstairs gallery will be used during the day for some events including sessions and that it will be open for late night session playing after the Friday and Saturday Fox Theatre concerts until 1am. RIO CUCHARA INN Located on Hwy 160 half way between La Veta and Walsenburg’s Fox Theatre. Individual room prices start at \$50. They are offering their big suite that can sleep eight to ten people for \$300 for the combined Friday and Saturday nights. It includes a small kitchen facility and continental breakfast is provided. General lodging

If you want to be in the center of festival activities, staying in La Veta would be your first choice, On offer are simple inexpensive camping and caravan sites to attractive inns and B & B's, with a wide range of prices to fit individual budgets. The same goes for lodging in Walsenburg where there are even more choices of motels and RV camps. Both towns have websites listing their lodging offerings.
